Microgrant Program

❑ Core Service Microgrants

- Small grants provided to CFAR members to access services offered by our scientific cores.

❑ Publication/Travel Microgrants

- Small grants to cover publication fees, poster printing, and travel to scientific conferences.

❑ Funding is provided up to \$2,500.

- Investigators may apply for larger microgrants for NGS lab services— up to \$5,000

Pilot Awards Program

- ❑ The DC CFAR Pilot Awards Program aims to provide pilot funds on a competitive basis to HIV/AIDS investigators to assist them in the development of their NIH-funded research careers.
- ❑ Each year there are between one and three award cycles and we provide funding for proposals up to \$50,000.

Transitioning Investigators Awards Program

- ❑ This program is designed for established investigators in non-HIV fields, who have not received an NIH award for HIV/AIDS research, and are interested in applying their scientific expertise within the HIV/AIDS field.
- ❑ Each year there are between one and two award cycles and we provide one-year pilot funding up to \$100,000.
