

# History of Nov 2013 JAIDS Supplement

- ❑ Dec 2012: DC D-CFAR proposed supplement concept to JAIDS and received approval from Editor in Chief
- ❑ Jan 2013: Received budget estimates from JAIDS
- ❑ Jan-Feb 2013: Contacted 9 ECHPP-1 site PIs to determine interest, feasibility of timeline and availability of funds
- ❑ Mar 2013: Working titles and draft table of contents sent to JAIDS
- ❑ Mar 2013: Guest editors identified from CDC and NIMH

# “Value Added” of Supplement

- ❑ Important scientific results on ECHPP and the HIV Continuum of Care shared with the field in a timely fashion
- ❑ Academic PIs and DOH colleagues co-authored manuscripts
- ❑ Demonstrated scientific productivity to the NIH which can help to justify their support of Working Group projects
- ❑ Consistent with JAIDS research focus area on HIV implementation science
- ❑ JAIDS supportive of the concept of a supplement series from Working Group
