The aim of this template is to ensure that concepts that have been contemplated or proposed are given the time and resources needed to be both fully developed and fully representative of the insights and contributions of the full project team. The template provides an accountability mechanism for ensuring that team members have been consulted and engaged and that the timeline for input is transparent. This template can be modified to match the needs of any academic-community partner team. In our collaborations it typically provides the "agenda" for bi-weekly team paper meetings.
